# KEY STORYLINES

- LIV Golf returns to Spain and the iconic Real Club Valderrama for the second consecutive year
- Legion XIII, captained by Spanish star Jon Rahm, won the previous LIV Golf tournament in Nashville for its third team victory of the season
- England's Tyrrell Hatton, a member of Legion XIII, looks to go back-to-back after winning his first individual LIV Golf title in Nashville
- Rahm and Hatton rank second and third, respectively, behind Torque GC Captain Joaquin Niemann in the individual points standings

# SPANISH HOMECOMING

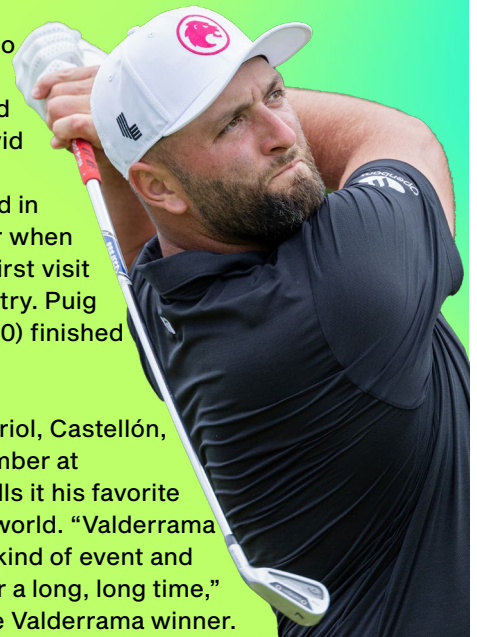
Four Spanish-born LIV Golf players, including first-year member Jon Rahm, will have plenty of support this week as they compete in front of their home fans at LIV Golf Andalucía.

Rahm, the two-time major winner and captain of the expansion Legion XIII team, makes his first visit to Valderrama since joining LIV Golf in the offseason.

"It's always special to go back to Valderrama," said Rahm, born in Barrika in Basque Country. "It's a golf course with so much history – so much Spanish history – and I'm glad to be going back with the level of field and competition it deserves."

Major winner Sergio Garcia, the captain of Fireballs GC, and his teammates David Puig and Eugenio Chacarra competed in Andalucía last year when LIV Golf made its first visit to their home country. Puig (T5) and Garcia (T10) finished inside the top 10.

Garcia, born in Borriol, Castellón, is an honorary member at Valderrama and calls it his favorite golf course in the world. "Valderrama has deserved this kind of event and this kind of field for a long, long time," said the three-time Valderrama winner.

# 2024 COMPETITION FORMAT

At the core of LIV Golf regular-season tournaments are the simultaneous individual and team competitions that create the sport’s most unique competition. As the LIV Golf League heads into its second full year, adjustments have been made to enhance the drama and build on the world-class fields that compete across the globe.

## HOW IT WORKS

### TEAM

- Team standings for the regular season will determine the seeds for the season-ending Team Championship
- The top three teams at the end of the regular season receive first-round byes
- Team points are awarded at each regular-season tournament to the top eight finishers

### INDIVIDUAL

- Individual points earned throughout the season will be used to calculate the individual standings
- The highest-ranked player following the Individual Championship event will be named the 2024 Individual Champion
- The top three players at the end of the regular season will earn individual bonuses

#### LOCK ZONE

Players finishing in the top 24 at the end of the Individual Championship secure their 2025 spot in the LIV Golf League

#### OPEN ZONE

Players finishing 25-48 are open to potential trade, release or re-signing by their team

#### DROP ZONE

Players finishing 49 and below are relegated out of the LIV Golf League and qualify for LIV Golf Promotions

# THE COURSE

## REAL CLUB VALDERRAMA

Sotogrande, Cádiz, Spain

- Ranked among the top courses in the world, Real Club Valderrama has hosted numerous professional events, including last year’s LIV Golf Andalucía, along with the 1997 Ryder Cup – the first time the event had been held in Continental Europe
- Valderrama was originally designed by famed golf architect Robert Trent Jones in 1974. Jones was brought back to work on the course when Jaime Ortiz-Patiño bought the course in the mid-1980s
- Valderrama is widely considered to be the “Augusta of Europe” for its championship pedigree and immaculate maintenance
- The golf club is one of two in Europe to be awarded the Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary Program Certification for its commitment to conserve and restore natural ecosystems
- The course will have four par-4 holes under 400 yards; the longest par 3 is 225 yards, the longest par 4 is 490 yards and the longest par 5 is 564 yards
- The 564-yard par-5 fourth, known as La Cascada, has a pond to the right of a two-tiered green
- The memorable 536-yard par-5 17th provides a natural amphitheater for fans
- Talor Gooch is the defending champion, winning last year at 12 under, one shot better than Bryson DeChambeau
- Green types: Bermuda Tifway 419 on fairways and rough; T1 Creeping Bentgrass on greens

# RICHARD BLAND

## TWO SENIOR MAJOR WINS

*“To go two-for-two is beyond my wildest dreams.”*

Cleeks GC star Richard Bland remains undefeated in senior majors this year, as he followed his Senior PGA Championship victory by winning the U.S. Senior Open after a spectacular bunker shot on the fourth playoff hole at Newport Country Club in Rhode Island.

The 51-year-old Englishman’s only senior starts have come in those two majors. After winning his first European Tour title in 2021 in his 478th start, Bland has now gone back-to-back against the world’s best 50-and-over golfers in 2024.

“I was just hoping going into the PGA that I was good enough to contend,” Bland said. “I hadn’t played against these guys. I knew if I played the way I know I can play, it should be good enough to be able to compete. But to stand here with two majors – I’m at a loss for words.”

Bland shot a final-round 66 to catch 54-hole leader Hiroyuki Fujita of Japan, with both players finishing at 13 under. Bland and Fujita then remained tied after a two-hole aggregate playoff and again after the third hole at sudden death. Bland then won after his shot from the greenside bunker at the 18th hole hit the flagstick and left him with a tap-in for par while Fujita suffered a bogey.

In addition to his two senior titles in the last six weeks, Bland and his Cleeks team, captained by Martin Kaymer, won their first-ever team title at LIV Golf Houston in June.

An original LIV Golf member, Bland has finished inside the top 24 Lock Zone to maintain his playing privileges for the last two league seasons. He said competing against the other LIV Golf players, including recent U.S. Open winner Bryson DeChambeau, has sharpened his game in the last three years.

“I’m a way better golfer than I was back then, but I think that’s the caliber of players that I’m playing against on LIV,” Bland said. “To play against Bryson, to play against Jon Rahm, Cam Smith, D.J. [Dustin Johnson], Brooks [Koepka] – they’re the best players in the world. I don’t care what the world ranking says.

“If I’m going to compete with those guys, I have to bring my game. I have to. I can’t bring my C game, and it won’t stack up against those. It just elevates my game, and I think it’s done that unbelievably over the last three years. It’s just made me a better player. You’re not always going to be playing your best golf, but I’m the best player I’ve ever been.”

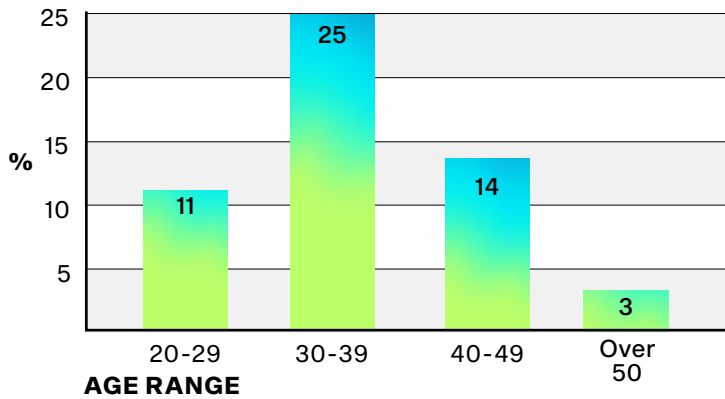
